The minutes of the January meeting were reviewed and approved with one correction. Mr. Stoddard will correct them and provide signature copies to the chairman.


Donna Esslinger presented images and estimated cost for the new street signs to be erected in the Historic District. The estimated cost for six black poles and six concrete bases, seventeen street signs with an arch, and seventeen without an arch, hardware for these, plus labor totaled \$2783.14. There will be some additional charge for shipping. The cost was determined to be within the MSHPC budget. Bob /stoddard moved to approve, seconded by Rod Hubble. Motion Carried unanimously.

Additional discussion was held regarding revisions to the Design Review Guidelines, the Ordinance, and various COA application forms. Several proposed corrections or revisions were studied. Mr. Underwood agreed to take those home and come up with a synopsis for consideration at our next regular meeting. The Subject was tabled until then.

The next regular meeting of the Magnolia Springs Historic Preservation Commission was set for Thursday, March 5th, at 4:00 PM at the Town Hall.
