**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO  
A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH  
UNITED WAY OF BALDWIN COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, the Magnolia Springs Town Council desires to provide certain public services to citizens and visitors to the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, the United Way of Baldwin County can provide those services at less cost and in a more effective manner than the town can provide with Town employees.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Council of the Town of Magnolia Springs, Alabama, while in regular session on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of February 2019 at 5:00 pm, that the Town of Magnolia Springs and the United Way of Baldwin County agree as follows;

United Way of Baldwin County partners with thirty-two (32) agencies to provide programs which strengthen the building blocks of a good quality of life – Education, Health, and Financial Stability. United Way of Baldwin County is committed to “Goals for the Common Good” – lowering the county’s high school dropout rate, promoting financial independence for families and improving the health of individuals in our community.

The Town of Magnolia Springs agrees to provide the sum of \$500.00 toward the funding of fiscal year 2019.
