

RESOLUTION 2020-45

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING THE DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR HURRICANE SALLY & HURRICANE ZETA


FINDINGS:

1. On October 27, 2020, Magnolia Springs Town Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-24 declaring a local State of Emergency to exist within the Town of Magnolia Springs due to Hurricane Sally.
2. Magnolia Springs Town Council has determined that the conditions which warranted local State of Emergency as authorized by the *Code of Alabama, 1975*, Section 31-9-2(a), have substantially receded and the declaration should be rescinded.
3. On October 6, 2020, Magnolia Springs Town Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-34 declaring a local State of Emergency to exist within the Town of Magnolia Springs due to Hurricane Zeta.
4. Magnolia Springs Town Council has determined that the conditions which warranted local State of Emergency as authorized by the *Code of Alabama, 1975*, Section 31-9-2(a), have substantially receded and the declaration should be rescinded.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
MAGNOLIA SPRINGS, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:**


