A Resolution Accepting, A Conservation Contribution For The Purpose Of Preserving And Protecting The Natural, Scenic And Open-Space Values Of The Natural Habitat Along the Magnolia River

WHEREAS, Charles S. Houser desires to made a conservation contribution to the Town of Magnolia Springs of approximately 1.1 acres of property lying along the banks of the Magnolia River; and

WHEREAS, the Town wishes to acquire such property for conservation purposes, which purpose is of great importance to both Town and its citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Magnolia Springs, Alabama, that:

Section 1. The Mayor Pro tempore and Town Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to accept, a Conservation Contribution to the Town of Magnolia Springs from Charles S. Houser for the purpose of protecting the natural, scenic and open-space values of the natural habitat along the Magnolia River; in substantially the form of deed presented to Council this date.

Section 2. This public acquisition by gift serves a public use and the conservation purposes of this contribution are of great importance to the Town of Magnolia Springs.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
