

RESOLUTION 2013-02

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE
APPLICATION TO THE ALABAMA HISTORICAL COMMISSION
FOR 2013 GRANT**

WHEREAS, the Town of Magnolia Springs has determined “that the historical, cultural and aesthetic heritage of the town is among its most valued and important assets”; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Magnolia Springs established a Historic Preservation Commission through Ordinance 2007-13 on September 25, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Historical Commission has made grants available to Certified Local Government programs to provide training for local historic preservation commissions through the FY 2013 Historic Preservation Fund; and


WHEREAS, the town ordinance creating the Historic Preservation Commission mandates yearly training for HPC members and staff; and

WHEREAS, this is an 80/20 grant of which \$5,000 will be funded by the Alabama Historic Commission and will require a cash match of \$1,000 from the Town of Magnolia Springs Historic Preservation Commission’s FY 2013 budget.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Magnolia Springs, as follows:
