

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-23

Resolution Adopting Transportation Plan Pursuant to the Rebuild Alabama Act and Repeal of Resolution No. 2019-13

WHEREAS, the Alabama legislature in Act. No. 2019-2 adopted the Rebuild Alabama Act;

WHEREAS, the Rebuild Alabama Act provides for an allocation among the municipalities of the state on the basis of the ratio of population of each municipality to the total population of all municipalities of the state a portion of the additional taxes levied under the Act to be used for transportation infrastructure, improvement, preservation and maintenance;

WHEREAS, the Act provides that the municipal governing body of the Town of Magnolia Springs shall adopt an annual Transportation Plan no later than <u>August 31</u>, <u>2020</u>, which shall provide a detailed list of projects for which expenditures are intended to be made in the next fiscal year and shall be based upon an estimate of the revenues anticipated from the fund in which the additional revenue is deposited during the next fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Act further provides that any such funds shall be used only for the maintenance, improvement, replacement, and construction of roads and bridges maintained by the Town of Magnolia Springs and such other uses as are defined in the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council of the Town of Magnolia Springs as follows:

- 1. The Town Council of the Town of Magnolia Springs, hereby, passes this Resolution as its Transportation Plan submitted in compliance with the Rebuild Act, Act No. 2019-2.
- 2. Pursuant to the Act, the Town Council of the Town of Magnolia Springs estimates that its anticipated allocation from the Rebuild Alabama Act fund for the first fiscal year will be approximately \$20,000.00, with increasing allocations for each fiscal year thereafter.
- 3. Pursuant to the Act, the City anticipates expending funds received pursuant to the Act, in part or in whole, to fund any of the following listed projects:



- School Street
- Section of Street in Village Green
- Twin Oaks Drive South End
- 4. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and instructed to post a copy of this Resolution as its Transportation Plan at the Town Municipal Hall, and on the website of the Town of Magnolia Springs.
- 5. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to establish a separate fund maintained by the Town of Magnolia Springs for receipt and deposit of funds received pursuant to the Act, the proceeds of which shall be expended solely for the maintenance, improvement, replacement and construction of roads and bridges maintained by the Town and such other uses as are authorized by the Act.
- 6. Repeal of prior resolution, Resolution No. 2019-13 adopted by the governing body of the Town of Magnolia Springs, Alabama on August 27, 2019; respectively, shall be and hereby is repealed, such repeal to become effective on the effective date of this resolution.

FISCAL YEAR 2020/2021 TOWN OF MAGNOLIA SPRINGS TRANSPORTATION PLAN

In accordance with the Rebuild Alabama Act signed into law March 12, 2019, the Town of Magnolia Springs hereby adopts this annual Transportation Plan to use the estimated revenues of \$20,000.00 anticipated from the Rebuild Alabama Act (Fuel Bill) fund during Fiscal Year 2020/2021 to perform roadway improvements, repairs, resurfacing, reconstruction or maintenance of School Street, a section of street in Village Green, and Twin Oaks Drive south end; and/or as match monies for any state or federal grant funded projects to perform roadway improvements, repairs, resurfacing, reconstruction or maintenance within our existing street/road network during said fiscal year.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the TOWN OF MAGNOLIA SPRINGS has caused this Fiscal Year 2020/2021 Town of Magnolia Springs Transportation Plan to be executed in its name and on its behalf by its Mayor and Town Clerk/Treasurer on this the 25th day of August 2020, at the Regular Council Meeting that was passed by the Town Council of the Town of Magnolia Springs.
