**A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO
THE MIRACLE LEAGUE OF COASTAL ALABAMA**

WHEREAS, the Magnolia Springs Town Council desires to provide public services to its residents and visitors for the purpose of enhancing the lives of local children and adults facing serious physical and mental disabilities;

WHEREAS, the Town of Summerdale has donated land for the construction of the Miracle League complex, comprised of a baseball field and playground, with the intent that its central location will service all of Baldwin County;

WHEREAS, the Town Council determines that appropriating funds for the purpose of building a regional Miracle League complex is in the best interest of the citizens of Magnolia Springs, Alabama;

WHEREAS, the Town agreed to the payment of the total sum of \$650.00 to Miracle League of Coastal Alabama toward the funding of the construction of a Miracle League complex in Summerdale, Alabama;


