
**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN
INTERGOVERNMENTAL SERVICE AGREEMENT
WITH THE BALDWIN COUNTY COMMISSION
TO USE THE COUNTY'S VOTING MACHINES AND SERVICES
OF THE COUNTY VOTING MACHINE CUSTODIAN FOR
MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS**

WHEREAS, as authorized by Code of Alabama 1975, Section 11-102-1, providing for a determination by the Baldwin County Commission to enter into an *Intergovernmental Service Agreement* with municipalities in Baldwin County, Alabama, to allow the municipalities to use the County's voting machines and services of the County Voting Machine Custodian for Municipal Elections.

WHEREAS, the Town of Magnolia Spring desires to execute an *Intergovernmental Service Agreement* with Baldwin County Commission to allow the Town of Magnolia Springs to use the County's voting machines and services of the County Voting Machine Custodian for the Town of Magnolia Springs municipal elections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Magnolia Springs, authorize by resolution for the Mayor to enter into *Intergovernmental Service Agreement* with the Baldwin County Commission to use the County's voting machines and services of the County Voting Machine Custodian for municipal elections.
