

## Ordinance 2012-02

## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A VOTING AND POLLING PLACE FOR ALL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS FOR THE TOWN OF MAGNOLIA SPRINGS

WHEREAS, Alabama law at Title 11-46-21, *Code of Alabama, 1975*, provides that the regular municipal elections in cities and towns in Alabama shall be held on the fourth Tuesday in August 1984, and quadrennially thereafter and, when necessary as provided in subsection (d) of Title 11-46-55, a second or runoff election shall be held the sixth Tuesday next thereafter following said regular election; and

WHEREAS, Alabama law at Title 11-46-24, Code of Alabama, 1975 requires the municipal governing body designate voting places for municipal elections; and

**WHEREAS,** the citizens of the Town of Magnolia Springs have voted at the Magnolia Springs Wesleyan Church in past County, State and Federal elections, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Magnolia Springs, Alabama has determined that it is in the best public interest to use the Magnolia Springs Wesleyan Church for a voting and polling place for all municipal elections for the Town of Magnolia Springs; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MAGNOLIA SPRINGS, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOW:

- 1. The voting and polling place for all municipal elections for the Town of Magnolia Springs, Alabama, shall be at the following location:
  - a. The Magnolia Springs Wesleyan Church located at 12233 Magnolia Springs Highway, Magnolia Springs, Alabama
- 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon approval and adoption in its publication and/or posting as required by Alabama law.
