

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-26

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS TO BE USED
FOR ENGAGING THE SERVICES OF A PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER, VOLKERT, INC.,
TO UPDATE THE 2009 STORMWATER INFRASTRUCTURE DRAINAGE PLAN
WITHIN TOWN LIMITS**

WHEREAS, the Town of Magnolia Springs has prioritized stormwater infrastructure improvements as a preferred strategy to mitigate flooding, improve resiliency and protect water quality; and

WHEREAS, more frequent heavy downpours have led to an increased demand for stormwater infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, local municipal governments often lack the financial resources to invest in stormwater infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, municipal stormwater infrastructure improvements benefit all residents of Magnolia Springs; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Magnolia Springs was allocated \$195,447.82 through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, which must be obligated by the end of 2024 and spent by the end of 2026;

WHEREAS, the Town of Magnolia Springs Town Council approved Resolution 2022-07, allowing Volkert, Inc. to update the 2009 Drainage Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Magnolia Springs hereby allocates \$103,400 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 funds to be used for engaging the services of a professional engineer, Volkert, Inc. to update the 2009 stormwater infrastructure drainage plan within town limits.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary for the implementation and reporting of all matters related to this expenditure.
