
The minutes for February 1, 2018 were reviewed and approved. Mary Freeman made a motion to accept; Ross Houser seconded; all approved.

The Commissioners reviewed and discussed a COA submitted by R.L. Farmer, Jr. of 14505 Oak Street. The extent of the work was determined to be minor work for the construction of a six (6) foot high wooden privacy fence on the north and east side of the property. Similar materials were being used; and the new fence was filling in gaps between the existing fence.
