

RESOLUTION 2021-13

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING THE DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR HURRICANE IDA


FINDINGS:

1. On August 27, 2021, Magnolia Springs Town Council adopted Resolution No. 2021-12 declaring a local State of Emergency to exist within the Town of Magnolia Springs due to Hurricane Ida.
2. Magnolia Springs Town Council has determined that the conditions which warranted local State of Emergency as authorized by the *Code of Alabama, 1975*, Section 31-9-2(a), have substantially receded and the declaration should be rescinded.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
MAGNOLIA SPRINGS, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the Magnolia Springs Town Council hereby rescinds Resolution No. 2021-12, thus ending the declared local State of Emergency; and
2. That this Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
